HOT SPRING COUNTY (2-24) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Hot Spring County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of this project is to resurface 4 miles of U.S. Highway 67 north of U.S. Highway 270B.

Cranford Construction Company of North Little Rock was awarded the contract at \$1,128,259.93.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in mid-2016.

HOT SPRING COUNTY (2-24) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Hot Spring County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of this project is to resurface 6 miles of State Highway 84 between Social Hill and State Highway 171.

Cranford Construction Company of North Little Rock was awarded the contract at \$834,823.72.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in mid-2016.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in mid-2016.
