Arkansas Highway Commission Approves Bid for Improvements in Benton County

BENTON COUNTY (11-10) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Benton County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of this project is to construct a railroad overpass bridge on new location for State Highway 43 in Siloam Springs.

Manhattan Road & Bridge Company of Tulsa, OK was awarded the contract at \$10,103,427.10.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in early 2018.

Arkansas Highway Commission Approves Bid for Improvements in Benton County

BENTON COUNTY (11-10) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Benton County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of this project is to extend 8th Street in Bentonville, construct a new interchange at 8th St. and Interstate 49, make improvements to the interchange at U.S. Highway 62 and State Highway 102, and add auxiliary lanes on I-49 between the two interchanges.

Crossland Construction Company, Inc. of Columbus, KS was awarded the contract at \$28,808,497.29.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in early 2018.
