Arkansas Highway Commission Approves Bid for Improvements in Prairie County

PRAIRIE COUNTY (11-10) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Prairie County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of this project is to replace the Interstate 40 White River Bridge and construct roadway approaches for approximately 1.2 miles on I-40 near Fredonia.

Parsons-Mahan of Westminster, CO was awarded the contract at \$100,559,842.64.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in mid-2019.
