Routine Inspection Requires Alternating Lane Closures on U.S. Highway 70 over Cache River

PRAIRIE COUNTY (9-16) – A routine inspection of the U.S. Highway 70 bridge over the Cache River requires alternating lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The bridge on U.S. Highway 70 where it crosses the Cache River will have <u>alternating north</u> and <u>southbound lane closures</u> from **9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.,** for **Monday, September 19,** weather permitting.
