Maintenance Work Requires Temporary Closure on State Highway 289 in Fulton County

FULTON COUNTY (10-3) – Repairs to a drainage system will require the closure of a section of State Highway 289 north of Horseshoe Bend in Fulton County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will require closure of State Highway 289 between State Highway 354 and U.S. Highway 62. This closure will begin on **Monday, October 10**, at **8:00 a.m.** and end on **Friday, October 21** at **5:00 p.m., weather permitting.** Motorists traveling on State Highway 289 will follow a detour.

- The northbound detour route is State Highway 354 west to State Highway 9 and then U.S. Highway 62 east.
- The southbound detour route is U.S. Highway 62 west to State Highway 9 south and then State Highway 354 east.

Local traffic should consider alternate routes between State Highway 354 and U.S. Highway 62. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
