Construction Requires Overnight Lane Closures and Traffic Stops along Interstate 40 Work Zone

FAULKNER COUNTY (11-10) – Construction work will require overnight lane closures and traffic stoppages in the work zone itself, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Starting on **Monday, November 14,** and continuing daily through **Thursday, November 17,** from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m.** the following traffic restrictions will be in place:

- o I-40 eastbound, 2 inside lanes closed
- o <u>Temporary traffic stoppages in the outside eastbound lane for 15 minute intervals between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.</u>
- o I-40 westbound, 1 inside lane closed

These closures will allow crews to erect the steel girders for the 6th Street Overpass between Oak Street (Exit 127) and Dave Ward Drive (Exit 129), weather permitting.
