Construction on State Highway 102 Requires Overnight Lane Closures in Bentonville

BENTON COUNTY (02-10) – Construction work on State Highway 102 in Bentonville requires overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Beginning **Monday night, February 13**, crews will perform bridge construction on the Interstate 49 bridge over State Highway 102. The outside lanes of westbound and eastbound State Highway 102 will alternately be closed to allow for construction between Moberly Lane and Eagle Way. One lane of eastbound and westbound traffic will always remain open. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and flaggers.

Weather permitting, these lane closures will occur from **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.**, from **Monday night, February 13** through **Saturday morning, February 18**.

This project (Job CA0902) is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 3.5 miles of I-49 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends from Highway 62/102 to Highway 72 and includes constructing auxiliary lanes from Highway 62/102 toward Southeast Walton Boulevard. Construction is expected to complete in late 2017.
