### **Maintenance Work Requires Road Closure in Dallas County**

**DALLAS COUNTY (9-8)** – Maintenance work near the Community of Dalark will require a temporary road closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; State Highway 8 from Dalark to Princeton will be closed to through traffic starting on **Monday, September 11** through **Wednesday, September 13**. This closure will allow maintenance crews to replace a pipe culvert on State Highway 8 between Manning and State Highway 7.

Traffic that is southbound on State Highway 7 should continue south to Sparkman, take State Highway 128 to Holly Springs, and then take State Highway 9 to return to Princeton. Local traffic will be allowed through the work zone.
