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Construction Requires Temporary Lane Closures and Uneven Pavement on State Highway 412 through Siloam Springs

BENTON COUNTY (9-20) – Construction work on State Highway 412 requires temporary lane closures and uneven pavement in Siloam Springs, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Work is ongoing and will continue through the period of Northwest Arkansas' Bikes, Blues, and BBQ beginning **Wednesday, September 20, 2017**. Motorists and cyclists should exercise caution through the construction zone. Advance warning signs, flaggers, and cones will be used to notify motorists approaching the construction zones. Work should be completed next week weather permitting.

APAC Central, Inc. of Fayetteville, AR was awarded the State Highway 412 overlay contract at \$1,414,945.75. This project will overlay approximately 3 miles of the highway with new asphalt.
