Maintenance Requires Lane Closures on State Highway 107 near Jacksonville Air Force Base

PULASKI COUNTY (11-22) – Replacing a drainage structure on State Highway 107 by the Jacksonville Air Force Base (AFB) requires lane closures in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; traffic will be reduced to one lane on State Highway 107 starting on **Monday, November 27** through **Thursday, November 30**, a half mile south of the Jacksonville AFB back gate between **9:00 a.m.** and **3:00 p.m.** daily.

Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
