### **Improvements Require Temporary Lane Closures on Interstate 40 in Galloway**

**PULASKI COUNTY (2-2)** - Improvements on the State Highway 391 and Interstate 40 interchange require temporary lane closures in Galloway, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, **on Monday, February 5<sup>th</sup>**, crews will close the outside I-40 westbound lane and exit ramp (Exit 161) to State Highway 391 from **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.**

Weather permitting, on **Wednesday, February 7<sup>th</sup>**, crews will close the outside I-40 eastbound lane and exit ramp (Exit 161) to State Highway 391 from **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.**

I-40 traffic exiting onto State Highway 391 will be detoured west on I-40 to I-440 west then U.S. Highway 70 east back to State Highway 391. Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
